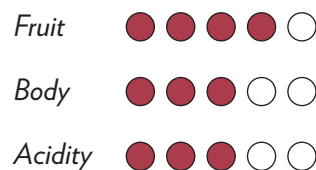


2018 RIGHT BANK PINOT NOIR
