

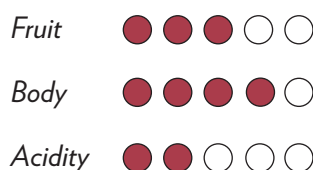

Van Duzer Corridor	The Field of Dreams vineyard sits on a rectangular piece on land that was cleared for agricultural use on the eve of World War I. The 100 year old plot was acquired by Left Coast Cellars in 2008 and planted with Pinot Blanc, Syrah, Viognier, Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, and Pinot Meunier. A perfect balance of soil types, elevation, and altitude makes the Field of Dreams of our most exciting vineyards going into the future and a perfect home for our Viognier.
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
