

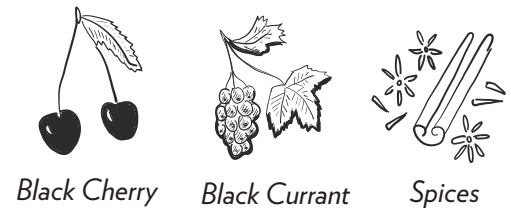
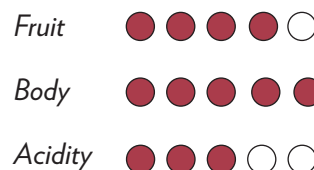

2021 LATITUDE 45 PINOT NOIR



Winemaker's notes: The wine has a savory characteristic with delicate dark fruit, clove, and resin aromas. Indian spices, black currant, black cherries, and forest floor dominate the palate with a richness and tension toward fine-grained tannins, favoring a sweet fruity texture and flinty finish.

VINEYARD NOTES

Planted: 2001
Acreage: 10.4 acres
Elevation: 272 feet
Varietal: Pinot Noir (Dijon 777, 667, 115, and 114)

The Latitude 45 Vineyard is directly intersected by the 45th parallel, like many of the great vineyard properties of France. Below the shallow soil is fractured silt stone, containing sea shells and fossils. Just above the Latitude 45 vineyard we have the second largest erratic boulder in the State of Oregon.
